

Keynote Speakers

Dr. E. Denis Wilson, MD developed the concept of Wilson's Temperature Syndrome in 1988 after observing people with symptoms of low thyroid and low body temperature who had normal blood tests. He found that by normalizing their temperatures with "sustained-release" T3, their symptoms often remained improved even after the treatment was discontinued. Over time he fine-tuned the intervention to arrive at the WT3 protocol. Dr. Wilson is the author of *Wilson's Temperature Syndrome: A Reversible Thyroid Problem*, and the *Doctor's Manual for Wilson's Temperature Syndrome*.

Dr. Michaël Friedman, ND is the formulator of WTS Formulas. He has designed natural medicines for endocrine and a variety of other disorders. Dr. Friedman was the principal investigator of a pilot study investigating the efficacy of botanical medicine to treat Diabetes. A Naturopathic Physician and herbalist, he is a former professor of Endocrinology at the University of Bridgeport. Dr. Friedman is the author of the forthcoming medical textbook: *Fundamentals of Naturopathic Endocrinology*.
